Robot Delivery Association Launches Today

Tokyo, **February 18**, **2022** – Today, eight companies*¹ – Honda Motor Co., Ltd., Japan Post Co., Ltd., Kawasaki Heavy Industries, Ltd., Panasonic Corporation, Rakuten Group, Inc., TIER IV, Inc., TIS Inc. and ZMP Inc. – launched the Robot Delivery Association with the aim of providing greater convenience to people's lives through the use of delivery services provided by autonomous delivery robots.
